God Still Speaks

God is a great Communicator. From the very beginning of time, He has been speaking. Just notice how often the phrase "God said" appears in Genesis 1. Truly, the universe was created by His powerful Word. Hebrews 11:3 says, "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear."

Then, after creating man, God established communication with him. Even after Adam fell into sin, God came looking for him in the garden and called to him. (Gen. 3:9) And down through the ages, God has been sought to communicate with mankind. Just look at the Scriptures, and you see God speaking – calling people to Himself, guiding and directing. Cain, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Gideon, David, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Daniel – the list goes on and on.

God even spoke to pagan rulers like Abimelech, Pharaoh, Nebuchadnezzar, Cyrus and others. Sometimes this communication was direct. Other times it was through the mouth of prophets, His written Word, or dreams and visions. One time, it was even through the mouth of a donkey!

Scripture tells us that when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son to speak His words and do His works in the world. Hebrews 1:1-2 says:

"God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;"

Yes, God spoke through His Son – the incarnate Word of God – the Word of God in bodily form. (John 1; Col 1:19). Jesus Christ is the very image of the invisible God – the exact manifestation of His likeness. (Col 1:15, Heb. 1:3) He came to communicate to us what God is like, to bring reconciliation, and to redeem a people for Himself. He demonstrated God's power, holiness, wisdom, goodness, kindness, compassion, and mercy. He came to heal, forgive, comfort, and deliver mankind from the bondage and effects of sin – to demonstrate grace and truth and to destroy the works of the devil.

This same God Who spoke in creation and down through the ages is still communicating with mankind today. He still speaks through the created world (Romans 1:20), through His written Word, and by His Spirit. He speaks through circumstances, through His people, and even at times through dreams and visions. (Acts 1:17) (I haven't heard of Him speaking through a donkey in modern times, but hey, He even speaks through me at times, so maybe...!)

Indeed, our Creator is still speaking. His message is the

same – "Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth." "Come to Me and you will find rest." "Trust in Me and you will be saved."

During this season, when Christians all over the world celebrate the birth of Jesus, may we hear His voice, humble ourselves, and respond to Him in faith and love.

Lord, give us eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to believe You. Help us learn to recognize Your voice and respond to Your love. 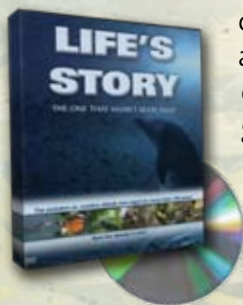

Not only does God communicate through His creation and to mankind, we also see that many of His creatures are also able to communicate in unique and interesting ways. Consider the following examples:

Ants have always been known for being masters of communication. Mary Jo and I confirmed that while watching ants in a huge ant farm in a natural history museum. One ant was

carrying a very large load when it stumbled

crossing a narrow "log bridge." It

continued to grasp its load while hanging by one "arm" from the

bridge. Whether it said an audible "help-help" or released an odiferous chemical signaling it needed help we don't know, but it communicated its need in such a way that other ants responded from a distance away. They dropped their loads, and rallied to help the ant in distress. It was certainly effective communication! I'm sure we can learn a lesson about helping others from that – both in communicating the need and in responding to the need.

has a pet knows that animals communicate. Dogs and cats tell you, "Hey, feed me," by carrying their bowl to you or by using their imploring eyes to stare back and forth from you to their bowl. Some become virtual masters of

begging. Even pet fish communicate through the glass of the aquarium by congregating as close to you as possible and opening their mouths, saying "Feed me!"

Dolphins use sounds like whistles and clicks to find each other. Researchers are noting that they also use body language to communicate various things. They

arch their backs, roll their eyes, wag their heads, etc. The researchers are also trying to discover other ways they "talk" to each other.

I have watched huge flocks of birds all flying together. Suddenly, they all turn as if they were a squadron practicing for the Blue Angels jet squad. I wondered why the birds could all suddenly change their course simultaneously without crashing into each other. There must be some type of communication going on. **AOI**

Bee Dances and Communication

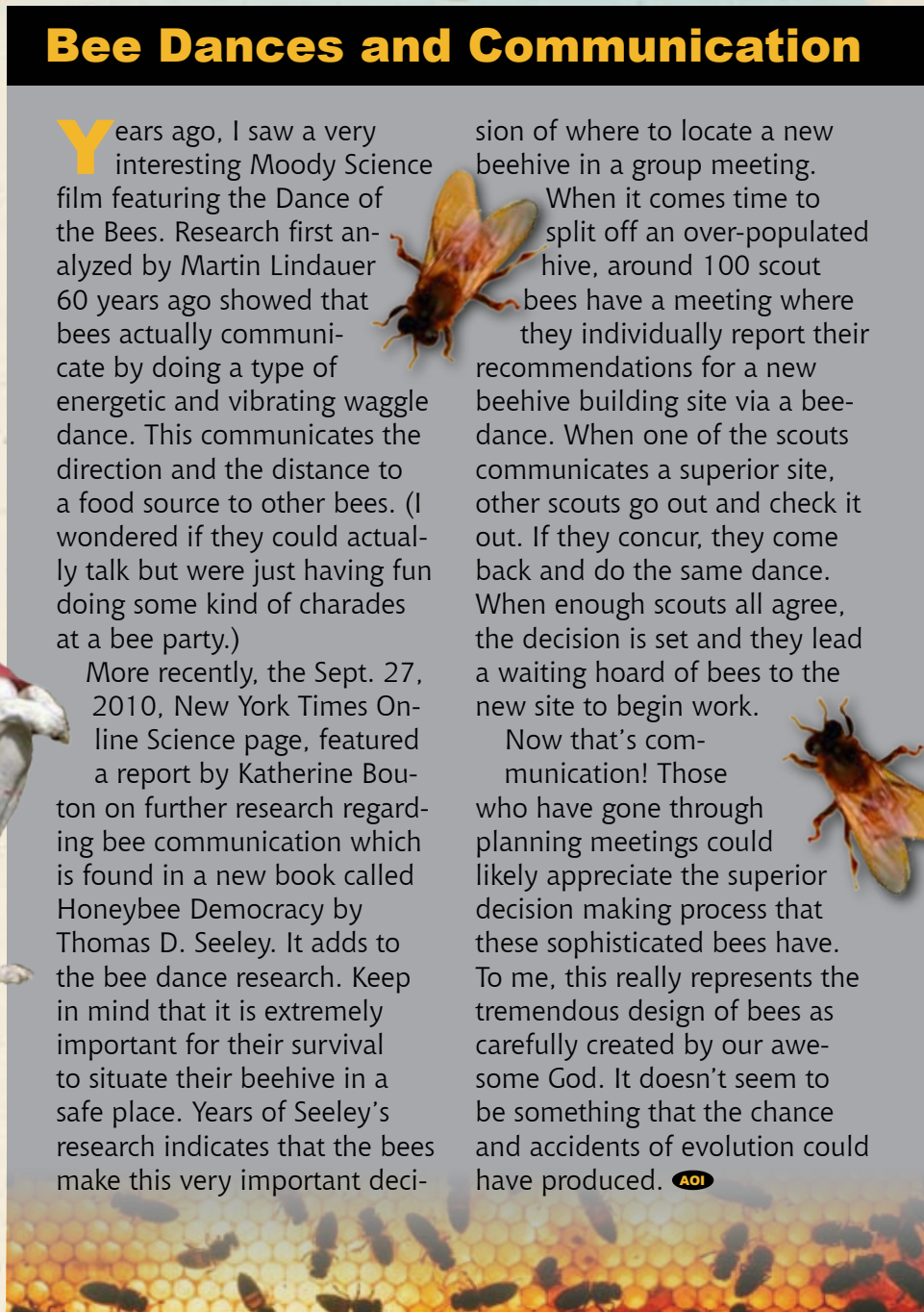
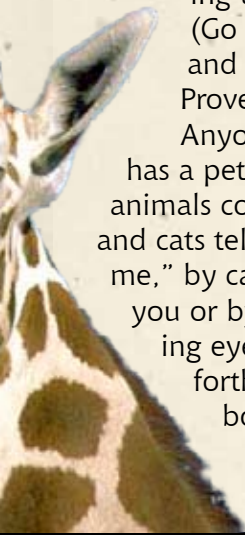
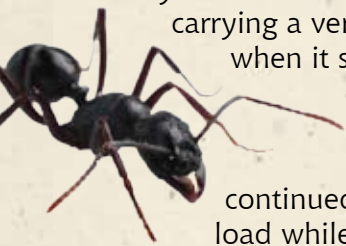
Years ago, I saw a very interesting Moody Science film featuring the Dance of the Bees. Research first analyzed by Martin Lindauer 60 years ago showed that bees actually communicate by doing a type of energetic and vibrating waggle dance. This communicates the direction and the distance to a food source to other bees. (I wondered if they could actually talk but were just having fun doing some kind of charades at a bee party.)

More recently, the Sept. 27, 2010, New York Times Online Science page, featured a report by Katherine Bouton on further research regarding bee communication which is found in a new book called Honeybee Democracy by Thomas D. Seeley. It adds to the bee dance research. Keep in mind that it is extremely important for their survival to situate their beehive in a safe place. Years of Seeley's research indicates that the bees make this very important deci-

sion of where to locate a new beehive in a group meeting.

When it comes time to split off an over-populated hive, around 100 scout bees have a meeting where they individually report their recommendations for a new beehive building site via a bee-dance. When one of the scouts communicates a superior site, other scouts go out and check it out. If they concur, they come back and do the same dance. When enough scouts all agree, the decision is set and they lead a waiting hoard of bees to the new site to begin work.

Now that's communication! Those who have gone through planning meetings could likely appreciate the superior decision making process that these sophisticated bees have. To me, this really represents the tremendous design of bees as carefully created by our awesome God. It doesn't seem to be something that the chance and accidents of evolution could have produced. **AOI**
