

20 differences between the two Pangolin Scenes

• Position of big cloud on left. • Big birds flipped vertically (upside-down). • Top of tree on right missing. • Cloud in middle missing. • Pangolin on middle termite mound, short tongue.

· Missing branch on middle back trees. · Position of back ant hill.

 Extra termite mound behind termite mounds on bottom left and front.
 Position of mother pangolin and baby on log.

- · Missing branch on tree on right.
- · Right cloud flipped horizontally.
- Size of sun. Pangolin in tree tail is shorter. • Termite is missing on termite mound. • Birds on right, one missing. • Extra ant on log.
- Short root on bottom left of log.
- Missing limbs and leaves on left tree. Pangolin in left tree.
- Bird on left by tree.


