the Flood, carbon dating, the fossil




record, and

The Moon: Big Problem for Evolution

When considering any topic, it is important to learn the broad overview and understand the "Big Picture." We should evaluate everything in its appropriate context. That is why I joined AOI – because the big picture all around us screams of God and His design.

Let's take the moon for example. Evolutionists have suggested four possible hypotheses regarding how the moon could have come into existence.

First, there is the Fission Hypothesis that says that when the Earth was still molten, it was spinning so fast that a piece flung off and began spinning nearby.

Second, is the Nebular, or Accretion Hypothesis that says the earth and moon formed side by side at the same time.

Third, scientists have suggested the Capture Hypothesis where the moon was a wandering planet and got captured by the earth's gravity. 1

The most favored evolutionary scenario is the Giant Impact Hypothesis. It says that a mass the size of Mars collided with the earth about 4.5 billion years ago. This giant collision ejected large amounts of debris that scattered around the earth. Eventually, due to gravitational attraction, the earth and the moon formed simultaneously as all the rubble collected together. That giant collision is said to have caused the earth's tilt as well as the spinning of both the earth and moon.

Documentaries, museums, and scientists often promote the Giant Impact Hypothesis as if it were simply fact. However, there are many problems with it, and with all of these hypotheses. Even the fact that there are four main theories shows that there is not a good naturalistic model to account for the moon.

There are many things that had to have happened in just the right way for the moon to have formed naturally. Some of these are theoretically improbable, if not impossible.

For example, gravity, at those distances, is just not strong enough to shape the Earth or the Moon after a collision like that. Furthermore, Ph.D. Peter Noerdlinger in a New Scientist article states, "The collision has to be implausibly gentle, you practically need someone

to hold a Mars-sized object just above Earth and drop it, to avoid messing up Earth's orbit." In fact, new titanium measurements and computer models are presenting troublesome

inconsistencies for Giant Impact theorists. Daniel experts in lunar origins met at the Royal Society in London to correct the problems with their theory, but one of the lead researchers remarked after the event, "It's got people thinking about the direction we need to go to find a story that makes sense." 3

There is no solid explanation for the formation of the Earth's moon – or any moon for that matter. Yet, there are at least 146 moons in our solar system. This is a big problem for naturalism.

In addition, the characteristics of the earth and the moon appear too perfect to be explained by naturalism. The Moon stabilizes the Earth's tilt and refreshes the oceans due to tidal action. The Sun's size, mass, heat, and distance from Earth are perfect. Earth's circular orbit, rotation rate, tilt, magnetic field, and climate are perfect for life. When we look at the big picture, it seems obvious that God's creation is amazing. Praise God!
