A Tree Convicts a Murderer

All of God's creation is unique and wonderfully complex. Each tree, for example, is genetically different. That's the way our patient and detail-oriented Creator made them. It's another reason to stand in awe at the thoughtful design of this amazing world.

In May of 1992, young Denise Johnson was the victim of a heinous murder. Yet, it was the unique genetic code of two seed pods from a spindly, green, desert tree that pointed an accusing branch at her vicious killer.

Forensic botany has been used effectively for many years. Such scientific analysis helped determine the origin of the wood in a ladder used to kidnap Charles Augustus Lindberg, Jr., the 20-monthold child of Charles and Anne Morrow Lindberg in 1935. The many and unique benefits of forensic botany have only blossomed since then.

Why – and how – do plants become "witnesses" to crimes? Take a quick look outside for the answer. First, and foremost, plants can be found everywhere. They have been designed by our Creator with seeds or fruit, twigs, leaves, air-borne spores, and pollen. They can be found on the ground, under water, or in a bird's nest – just about anywhere and in any climate.

Each plant's unique characteristics are passed along

to the next generation. This allows a plant's DNA to help law enforcement determine the location of a crime, the season it occurred, whether or not a body has been moved, and how long a corpse has been buried. Pollen and spores,

for example, stick to clothing and can be inhaled into the lungs. Since they are slow to decay, having even been found in fossil samples, and because they're microscopic in size, they can serve as a voiceless witness to a crime. In contrast to fingerprints, footprints, and voiceprints, pollen is virtually invisible, making it nearly impossible to locate let alone eliminate. Scrubbing a crime scene of its presence is extremely unlikely. In 1993, a

University of Arizona plant geneticist, Tim Helentjaris, used forensic botany to

source the specific genetic codes of trees near and around where the Johnson murder occurred. This included a palo verde tree that had recently been hit by an unknown vehicle. He realized that if he could connect the tree to the suspect's vehicle, he could pinpoint the murderer.

In the accused's truck, there

happened to be two seed pods from a Palo Verde tree. Twelve separate trees were examined including the "injured" tree using the RAPD (Randomly Amplified Polymorphic DNA) technique. The conclusion: As expected, genetic segments differed from tree to tree.

Yet, amazingly, the samples from the tree scraped by a vehicle exactly matched the pods found in the suspect's truck. The geneticist testified that it was "highly likely" that the pods came from the injured tree and explained that it was "highly unlikely" that they could have come from any of the other trees at the scene. The jurors at the trial agreed and found the suspect, Mark Bogan, guilty of first-degree murder based on the unique "plant-prints" discovered.

Atheistic evolutionists dismiss the obvious details which point to a Creator God but trust in sheer, blind chance. It's far wiser to "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In



all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5-6, (KJV). Risking your eternal security on the long odds that evolutionary theory is

both accurate and reliable is like anchoring a swing to a broken branch. It is neither a good idea nor a secure one. @
