Why is Creation Important?

We have been asked why our ministry focuses on Genesis, God as Creator, and the evidence for the creation/flood accounts in our teaching and evangelism. There are several good answers to this question, and I will briefly lay out a couple of them.

The evolutionary worldview remains a huge stumbling block to many young people coming to faith in Jesus Christ

Maybe you've seen the statistics. Young people are walking away from the Church and from Biblical faith in alarming numbers. The reasons? Research shows that one of the biggest is because they cannot reconcile the Bible with what they've been told is "irrefutable science." Common thinking is that "science has proven the Bible wrong" or that we need to change the Bible to fit in with the conventional evolutionary story. But is that true?

I do not need to see statistics to understand the effects of an evolutionary worldview on the minds of young people. In over 20 years of youth ministry, I can testify that difficulty reconciling "science" and the Word of God is a huge obstacle to faith. Most young people have never heard a good defense of the Biblical account of creation, and unfortunately, very few churches teach anything about it. Many church kids (and adults) don't even realize there is a Biblical alternative to the evolutionary origins story! How sad is that? The good news, however, is that I've discovered through experience that many are eager to hear it, receive it, and believe it – they just need to

be told! For some, understanding creation can be the eye-opening beginning to true faith in Jesus Christ. Others, however, will walk away from the faith if they don't have their questions answered. As the Bible warns us in 1 Timothy 6:20-21, "Turn away from godless chatter and the opposing ideas of what is falsely called knowledge (also translated "science"), which some have professed and in so doing have wandered from the faith."

If God is not our Creator, then He cannot be our Redeemer. Job testified, "I know that my Redeemer lives." (Job 19:25) Christ as our Redeemer and the concept of redemption is at the core of the Good News of Jesus. Redemption can generally mean something good coming out of something bad, like the feel-good ending of July/August, 2023; Vol. 41, No.4

a movie. However, the biblical definition can be more intentional and specific: "to purchase back that which was previously yours but was lost." God doesn't just bring us a general feel-good movie story of overcoming evil, but gives a very specific message of "I have come to buy you back." The story of Hosea beautifully illustrates this kind of redemption when Hosea rescues his unfaithful wife, buying her back off the slavery block. She was already his wife, but he had to pay a steep price to **redeem** her when she left him for other lovers."

In the same way, Jesus paid heavily with His own blood to purchase you and me. He redeemed His lost creation from the clutches of sin and death. But logically, He cannot redeem that which He previously did not own. And logically, He does not own us if He did not create us. His right to us as His own, as well as His position as Judge and Lawgiver, cannot exist if He did not create us. Jesus, as Creator, means Jesus can also be our Redeemer. This is vital for us to understand. As it says in Colossians 1:16: "For by him [Jesus] all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him."

he Apostle Paul used creation to reach many pagan cultures. In Acts 17:16-31. he was confronted with a culture in Athens that worshiped many gods and had zero context for the Messiah or the Jewish scriptures.. (Acts 17:16-31) When Paul first began to reason with the Greeks about Jesus Christ, their response was, "What is this babbler trying to say?" (vs. 18) Sounds increasingly like our culture today in America, don't you think? How does one begin

to talk with people in such a culture about the reality of God, their sin, and their need for redemption? Where would you begin?

Paul started "in the beginning" with creation and the Creator. The true God was "unknown" to them, so Paul revealed Him to them as Creator. In verse 24 he tells them, "The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by hands." Continuing in verse 26, he says, "From one man he made every nation of men, that they should inhabit the whole earth."

People in our country used to have a collective understanding - at least in part - of the Bible and Judeo-Christian truths. But now we are a nation much like the pagan Greeks of Paul's time, most being ignorant of God and His Word. How do we introduce the liberating message of the Gospel to people in such a culture? Maybe it's best to start "in the beginning" and give an illuminating context for our message - there is only one God and that He created everything, including you and me!



Boulders in Coal?

So, what do boulders in layers of coal have to do with anything? More than you think! Read on.

The prevailing theory for the formation of coal deposits, that almost all students have learned, is the swamp theory. We are told that over vast amounts of time, small fragments of trees and other vegetation fell to the bottom of a swamp. Over eons of time, a huge amount of these fragments accumulated. The weight of the swamp debris as well as subsequent deposits of sand and other sediments, we are told, caused this mass to slowly sink deeper and deeper into the earth where temperatures get very hot. This heat slowly baked the debris which eventually caused it to become coal. "Millions" of years later, earth forces caused

these layers to be pushed up revealing very extensive beds of coal.

That idea seems to make sense if you don't consider some major problems. One of them is the fact that large boulders are sometimes found deep

within very rich coal deposits. In fact, a large machine (called a long-wall miner) which is used to cut the coal out of these beds, will sometimes clang to an abrupt halt when the blades encounter a boulder. Miners aren't happy with that as it means a major repair is necessary. Since large boulders don't grow in swamps, where did they come from? One clue is that some of the boulders in certain coal beds are



made of granite. However, the nearest source for the granite is 1,000 miles away. How did they get transported? The following is a possible

scenario which involves a lot

of water. If you have seen a tree that has fallen over, you might notice that the roots have entwined around boulders – some small and some very

large. In a major flood scenario, a vast amount of trees would have been ripped up and


transported great distances. Large numbers of these trees would form floating log jams. In rough waters, the trees in the log jam would rub and bang into each other causing water-logged debris to fall off and sink to the bottom.

Additionally, as smaller material was washed out of the roots, boulders could more easily have been dislodged. Roots would also break from the floating trees releasing the boulders into the accumulating debris underneath.

You now have a large boulder in the midst of a "peat bed." During a world-wide flood scenario, this "peat bed" would quickly become buried under massive amounts of additional flood debris

and sediments – eventually sinking deeper into the earth. There, the heat and pressure bake the peat to form a coal bed and cause the other layers to lithify (turn to sedimentary rock).

So, when a granite boulder 1,000 miles from the boulder's



scenario much more in keeping with Noah's Flood. In other words, the boulders in coal cry out, "Flood! – The Biblical account is true!"

We are enclosing an update of the AOI building remodel. Even though the

upstairs student apartments still need a lot of work, the downstairs is back to looking like our normal offices, meeting rooms, and library! This is after having to totally fireproof it from the upstairs apartments as required by the City. To do this, the ceiling was removed, electric conduit dropped, etc., etc., and a new ceiling was installed consisting of insulation placed between ceiling/floor joists. New, metal tracks had to be installed, and extra-thick, drywall screwed

to it. After that, every crack was fire-proofed. Underneath that new ceiling, brand new ductwork (required) and a fire sprinkler system (required) were put in place. After several other things, a new drop-ceiling frame and tiles were installed. Whew! We **passed** the final inspection on that and are currently trying to spruce it up.

The enclosed sheet delineates the current progress on the apartments and what is still left to do.
