Education or Indoctrination?

Millions of students are back in school for another year of "education." Will they receive true "education" or will it be another year of "indoctrination?" Will they learn reading, writing, math, true science, and explore the great literature which teaches sound moral principles? Or, will much of their time be spent on evolutionary dogma and an agenda that undermines solid Biblical teaching and destroys the faith of so many young people?

Many admirable teachers truly love kids and desire to see them grow into productive, morally responsible adults. Unfortunately, even these are usually required to use a particular curriculum, teach standardized objectives, and promote current social ideas. Sadly, many other teachers view their role as "change agents," promoting particular agendas. Some even think they're there to "free" their students from traditional moral standards, parental involvement, and anything consistent with Biblical teaching.

This battle is not new, but it's been escalating greatly in recent years. Some wonder how all this heated up "so quickly." However, the foundations of these anti-family, anti-Biblical teachings, including the indoctrination of the misused "separation of church and state," have been slowly laid over years. In actuality, this phrase is not found in our original founding documents. It's found in a letter Thomas Jefferson wrote to the Danbury Baptist Association of Connecticut in 1802. The Founders didn't want to see the establishment of a European style "State Church" even though they recognized, as John Adams wrote: "Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious People. In the early days of this nation, kids were taught to read through Bible lessons and learned multiple foreign languages. Even teens represented our country on foreign soils. How did they do so much at young ages? One reason is that the focus was **education rather than indoctrination**. Their education was based solidly on a Biblical foundation and understanding of God's identity as the sovereign Creator of the heavens and earth. This foundation impacted science as well as all other fields of learning.

Back then, scientists, for the most part, had a Biblical and Christian worldview. Scientists saw their work as "thinking God's thoughts after Him." Based on the book of Genesis, they believed in Creation, the Fall, the Flood, and the Dispersion after Babel. They viewed science as a key to understanding this physical world that God created and to fulfill the Genesis 1 mandate to "have dominion" over the physical creation.

So, what can parents and grandparents do? Homeschooled kids have many opportunities to use Christian curriculum and build a Biblical foundation. It's also vital to maintain good communication and provide Biblically positive resources. For kids in public or "Christian" schools, it's vitally important to talk about what they're learning in school, from friends (even "church" friends), and online. Provide quality opportunities like Creation books, videos, camps and tours.

Most importantly, we, as mentoring adults, must model a lifestyle of seeking the Lord, and developing a personal walk with Him, Information alone is not enough. Our kids need to have a personal relationship with the Lord – to know God's love, presence, and power – to walk in His ways.

We recently attended the International Conference on Creationism in OH. (See pg. 3.) After the conference, we visited Answers in Genesis'

Creation Museum and Ark Encounter. Both are very well done and provide abundant opportunities to learn more about Science, the Bible, Creation, and the

Flood. Objections are dealt with tastefully and positive answers are given for numerous "evidences" of evolution.

The Ark is BIG! This full-sized replica of the one described in Genesis 6-8 dispels the idea of a tiny boat packed with animals sticking their heads out the windows like so many kids' books display. Displays on the Ark's 3 floors show how space may have been used, with plenty of room for stored food, cages for the animals – complete with authentic reproductions. It also showed living and working



quarters for Noah and his family. Many displays answer objections skeptics raise including how they got light and fresh water into the Ark, how Noah and his family cared for all those animals, and even how they managed animal waste.

The Ark and the Creation Museum are both great options for a creation vacation. We were very impressed with the quality of the exhibits and the information presented. 

the details of prophetic utterances are precisely what are known to

have happened."

Creation Research Shared at the International Conference on Creationism

Years ago, we attended a lecture about the "Pseudo Science of Intelligent Design." During the Q&A session following the lecture, one science professor said that one of the problems he had with creationists was that their work was not peer-reviewed. Dave was able to share with him that in fact, right then, there was a technical

conference with peer-reviewed research in topics related to creation and evolution. The professor said, "I stand corrected. I'm glad to hear that."

The International Conference on Creationism (ICC) is a technical

scientific research conference. Scientists who want to present their research, submit technical papers of their work for peer review by other scientists. This conference has been held every 4-5 years starting in 1986. This year we were able to attend the conference hosted by Cedarville University, in Cedarville, OH.

Though many of the presentations were in areas other than our areas of expertise and went right over our heads, we were blessed by the opportunity to learn about current research, to see "old" friends, make new ones, and to be blessed by the fellowship of several hundred creationists.

Creation science has developed over the years from primarily exposing the errors of evolutionary teaching to developing a creation model, consistent with the Word of God and with sound, innovative scientific research. Here are just a few of the speakers and topics covered at ICC this year:


Please pray for God's leading, for funding, for wisdom and for insight to these scientists and others who
