"There Can't Be a God Because..." – Contradictory Atheist Claims

Skeptics offer many arguments when seeking to prove there is no God. Many times, those arguments contradict themselves and shed light on the true nature of mankind as a result of the Fall. Consider the following claims:

1. "There is no way a being could be powerful enough to create a universe."

In other words, forget Genesis 1:1 - "In the Beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."

2. "Things are too perfect for any God to accomplish."

I almost laughed when a university instructor pulled that argument out of his hat. It's amazing to see the lengths to which people will go in seeking to counteract the amazing evidence for design.

Actually, **both of these arguments fail** to understand the **power of our Creator-God**. Instead, both blindly ascribe incredible power to random processes to create an amazinglybalanced universe and mind-boggling complexity of living systems.

The Apostle Paul in Romans 1:20-22 states the evidence is there! "For since the creation of the world [God's] invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools,"

3. "Things aren't designed perfectly!"

True, we live in an imperfect world with death and disease. This type of imperfection is the direct result of Adam and Eve's sin in the Garden of Eden. Another facet of this "imperfection" argument questions God's design and ignores the possibility that our Creator had a specific reason for His design. This line of reasoning is heavily dependent on the opinions of scientists and their perceived expertise. In past issues of T&B, I answered some of these "imperfection" arguments regarding the eye (Jan-Feb, 2005) and for choking potential (Nov-Dec, 2014).

Another such argument in this "imperfection" category claims that if a God knew what He was doing, He would not have made the 4 different ways for DNA to code for the amino acid called glycine. Their claim is that this is wasteful. Therefore there can't be an all-knowing God Who created it.

Think about their logic. If it is too perfect, there can't be a God powerful enough to do it. If there are imperfections, then that also proves there is no God. Hmmmm...I guess if you don't want to believe in God, you are forced into a mental "disconnect."

True, each of the ways to make glycine differs by only the last of the 4 letters in the code. As a creationist who believes in the power of an almighty God, I would expect there is a purpose for His doing so. Sure enough, recent research confirms this! Inside the cell, an extremely complex (amazingly-designed!) machine folds the string of amino acids into a functional protein. The "wasteful" last letter controls the precise amount of folding needed. **WOW!** Our Creator-God has just revealed to us His amazing power to make a **dual coding system!** Ironically, **this added knowledge forces** those arguing for wasteful imperfection into the "too perfect" category!

Contrast this with a university professor who came to our presentations in Mongolia. He was trained as an engineer in the Russian, communist schools where he was also indoctrinated to be an atheist. In broken English, he told us "I've been thinking and thinking and thinking. Things are just too complex and too designed for them to happen by accident. Then I saw the advertisement for your programs and decided to come."

He received the evidence of a Creator gladly! I believe that the enormous complexity that God has placed all around us is meant to lead open-minded people like the Mongolian professor into recognizing that God is the powerful Creator!

Oh, God, let us see and accept your infinite power! You are a God worthy of our worship!

Questions Students Ask by Brian Mariani

1. Aren't all religions basically the same and don't they all lead to the same God?

Although many lay-people will make this claim, religious scholars would never say this. Though themes like love and goodness (morality) are often shared concepts, there are many contradictory and mutually-exclusive claims held by the world's various religions. In other words, the differences make all the difference.

For example, Mormons and Christians do not have the same understanding of God. Mormons believe that God was once a man and spiritually/ supernaturally evolved to be the God of this world. Christians, on the other hand, believe that God has always existed and is the only God there is .

To say that these two views lead to the same God is like saying two little, round, white pills are the same. However, if one is aspirin and the other arsenic, they'll produce drastically different results.

2. What about people in other religions? Would God really send people to Hell who are so sincere?"

You can sincerely believe that your parachute works but you can be sincerely wrong. No student

goes to the professor after a hard test and says, "I sincerely thought that I gave the right answers to the test, so can you please change my grade?" The important aspect of this is what is really true.

3.Why does Jesus have to be the only way, truth and life?

Soft Tissue in "Ancient" Fossils - Update

hen I was in my teens, I cut and polished many pieces of petrified dinosaur bone to make rock jewelry. On occasion, while I was shaping the stone, a rottenegg smell would exude from the "petrified" dinosaur bone. Sadly, as a young evolutionist, I never even thought about the significance of it. I later realized I was grinding through rotting soft tissue and thankfully, it wasn't mine! It wasn't until after the findings of Mary Schweitzer in the 1990's that scientists became aware of unpetrified, soft tissue in dinosaurs. (See Mark Sonmor's article relating to this in the May/June 2005 issue of Think & Believe.)

The question is obvious: How could any soft tissue have remained intact over all those supposed millions of years? All of it should have decayed! At first, there was just plain unbelief on the part of the scientific community. Many simply denied or ignored the research. In fact, Mary Schweitzer couldn't even get her research published for quite some time. When interviewed by Barry Yeoman of Discover magazine, she recalled:

"I had one reviewer tell me that he didn't care what the data said, he knew what I was finding wasn't possible. I wrote back and said, "Well, what data would convince you?" And he said, "None." ¹

I've had people say: "Impossible! You are making this up!" I agree with it being "impossible," but not with the making it up!

While speaking on the subject at the University of Minnesota, a professor shouted out, "It's just biofilm!" meaning that this is merely recent biologic activity that just looks like it was from the dinosaur. Today, it is fully acknowledged that the biofilm explanation is false. It is indeed unpetrified dinosaur soft tissue.

So, what do paleontologists who are hoping to retain their millions of years, do with this? Evolutionary researchers are frantically trying to come up with a plausible explanation. The latest research is led by Schweitzer, herself. She found that if tissue is soaked in concentrated hemoglobin to provide ample iron, the tissue could be preserved for two years. That sounds promising to dedicated evolutionists and is now the explanation I am hearing at the universities. However, I don't think it solves the dilemma. Why not? 1. It is a huge stretch to extrapolate from two years to 140 million! 2. It doesn't explain where the buried dinosaur is going to get all of that concentrated hemoglobin. 3. The experiment required that the bone and tissue be kept dry. However, the dinosaurs in question were buried guickly by mud in what is reported to have been a river (or Flood?) deposit. How do you keep it dry? Petrification itself, demands

continual flow of groundwater. 4. Many fossils containing soft tissue have no iron present.

Actually, many more fossils have recently been found with documented soft tissue. In 2011, ICR published a list of 42 such fossils. Pliable dinosaur skin was discovered in 2013. An Oct 3, 2017 article also reported the discovery of a "millions-of-years-old" salamander having intact soft tissue, nerves, and organs still preserved. It also showed evidence that it had just eaten a frog!² Many of the reports express amazement over the ability of soft tissue to remain intact over all those years!

These findings make me seriously question "all those years." I believe the evolutionary paradigm, which requires vast amounts of time, clouds the minds of paleontologists. It keeps them from questioning their basic, underlying assumptions – or

questioning the long-age time frame. Could there be another explanation – one that involves a huge, and much more recent Flood?
