Positive Evidence/Arguments for Atheism

-Perceived problems with Christianity are primarily the claims for why Atheism is true.

-Define Atheism

- Atheism is a lack of belief in God. It makes no claims.
- -You believe that: There is probably not a god based on the evidence. This is a claim that you make.
- -Do you believe that it is most likely based on the evidence that we are here now without a greater purpose and that there is nothing after death? That is a belief.
- -You make value judgments moral judgments claims to what is true.
- -Atheists have positive claims about the world that:
 - -The Big Bang was the beginning of the Universe.
 - -Evolution has happened to cause life.
 - -Christianity is not true.
 - -Fundamental Religious rules are wrong.
 - -War is bad/unfortunate.
 - -Christianity and other religions have led to wars.
 - -Atheists also have the burden of proof to prove their claims true too.
- -"Atheism is not a belief system nor is it a religion."
- "To put it in a more humorous way: If atheism is a religion, then not collecting stamps is a hobby."
- "Agnostic isn't just a "weaker" version of being an atheist. It answers a different question. **Atheism is about** what you believe. Agnosticism is about what you know."

Positive Evidence/Arguments for Christianity

- "I need to see evidence for God." Ask yourself these questions:
- -Is it possible for there to be a God?
- -Is it possible for there to be scientific evidence that points to God?
- -If I gave you evidence, would you seriously consider God?
- -What type of evidence do you want? Or how much evidence do you need?
 - -If you saw enough evidence, would you become a Christian, or even a Creationist?
 - -Direct Evidence vs. Circumstantial Evidence
 - -Reasonable not just possible.
 - -"Beyond a reasonable doubt, not 100%."

- 1. "Human artifacts are products of intelligent design; they have a purpose.
- 2. The universe resembles these human artifacts.
- 3. Therefore: It is probable that the universe is a product of intelligent design, and has a purpose.
- 4. However, the universe is vastly more complex and gigantic than a human artifact is.
- 5. Therefore: There is probably a powerful and vastly intelligent designer who created the universe." _i

I appreciate that when somebody says 'Love they neighbor as thyself,' they think they are referring above and beyond themselves Nevertheless, . . . such reference is truly without foundation. Morality is just an aid to survival and reproduction, . . . and any deeper meaning is illusory. . . . [9]

Friedrich Nietzsche, the great atheist of the last century who proclaimed the death of God, understood that the death of God meant the destruction of all meaning and value in life.

On the atheist view some actions, say, rape, may not be socially advantageous and so has become taboo but that does absolutely nothing to prove that rape is *really wrong*. On the atheistic view, if you can escape the social consequences there's nothing really wrong with your raping someone. -Free Will, Meaning/Purpose, Value, Morality, and Reason:

And also, think about this: If there is no God, we are just bags of chemicals reacting to our chemical environment due to the chemical natures of our brains (in other words, our thoughts must be products of chemical reactions) - so ULTIMATELY, from that perspective, we have no free will, no meaning or purpose to life, there is no value in humanity, there are no rights or wrongs - we just react chemically to our environment. The atheist has a much bigger problem of evil. An atheist can't say anything is wrong and be correct if their view is true. This also means that we can't be confident that are chemicals are reacting to allow correct/true reasoning/rationality. For the atheist that asks God to show Himself to them, I believe these are good evidences of God. He is showing Himself to us because it is more reasonable to conclude that from our intuition and experience (intuition and experiences are evidences), we have free will, meaning and purpose, value, and that there are rights and wrongs.

God allowed us a choice (that's creating creatures that can honestly love, not creating robots) and choosing counter to God's command caused and is causing pain, suffering, evil and death. Now God works through the pain, suffering, evil, and death to cause good results. And he did something roughly 2000 years ago to return everything to the way we think it should be - the way it was created to be. That those who believe will be forgiven and redeemed.
