



1. Position upper right blue trout. 2. Left cuttlefish missing tentacle. 3. Blue-green eel missing tail. 4. Position red cuttlefish. 5. Yellow long-nose length of nose. 6. Right seahorse tail. 7. Missing piece of middle green seaweed. 8. Size of blue fin on upper left big orange angel fish. 9. Missing leg on lower left crab. 10. Missing seaweed in front of blue-yellow striped angel fish. 11. Missing piece of top fin on pink perch on right. 12. Eye pupil on blue-green center top fish. 13. Position of bottom clam, 14. Color near tail of orange striped fish on center right. 15. Missing piece on upper right of red coral. 16. Missing rocks left of bottom starfish. 17. Missing leaf of seaweed on left. 18. Yellow longnose back behind seaweed
